- Linux
- A vulnerability in the in the Linux kernel through 4.8.12, which allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service attack.
- Linux
- A vulnerability in the Linux kernel before 4.6 allows local users to gain privileges or cause a denial of service attack.
- Joomla
- A vulnerability in the Joomla Core version 3.6.4 and prior allow attackers to execute arbitrary code.
- Apache
- A vulnerability in the Apache HTTP Server 2.4.17 through 2.4.23 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service attack.
- Roundcube
- A vulnerability in the Roundcube before 1.1.7 and 1.2.x before 1.2.3, allows remote authenticated users to execute arbitrary code.
