Description / Impact

- Apache
- A vulnerability in the Apache POI prior to 3.15 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service attack.
- Microsoft
- A vulnerability in the Internet Information Service (IIS) 6.0 in Microsoft Windows Server 2003 R2 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code.
- Linux
- A vulnerability in the Linux Kernel through 4.10.6 allows local users to cause a denial of service attack or unspecified other impact via crafted system calls.
- IBM
- A vulnerability in the IBM WebSphere Portal 8.5 and 9.0 allows users to embed arbitrary JavaScript code in the Web UI.
- NTP
- A vulnerability in the NTP before 4.2.8p10 and 4.3.x before 4.3.94 allows local users to execute arbitrary code via unspecified vectors.
