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## Security Updates for 27<sup>th</sup> January 2017

### Description / Impact

- Apache Storm
- A vulnerability in the Apache Storm 0.10.0 before 0.10.0-beta1 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code.
- Citrix
- A vulnerability in the Citrix Provisioning Services before 7.12 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code.
- Ntp
- A vulnerability in the ntp before 4.2.8p9 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service attack.
- Wordpress
- A vulnerability in the WordPress before 4.7.1 allows remote attackers to hijack the authentication of unspecified victims.
- Zimbra
- A vulnerability in the Zimbra Collaboration before 8.7.0 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML codes.
